SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

- » Graduands shall bring their proof of identity.
- » Graduands are requested to register their presence and enrollment in the Vinayaka Mission's Chennai Campus between 08.30 a.m. and 10.00 a.m. on 15.12.2023 (including those registered online).
- » Graduands should sit in the allotted seats by 11.00 a.m. sharp in formal dress. Graduands with informal dress will not be permitted into the Graduation Hall.
- » All Persons shall remain standing when the academic procession enters the hall and shall take their seats only after the members of the procession are seated.
- » After receiving degree certificates, Graduands shall go back to their respective seats and remain seated and maintain utmost discipline.
- » Graduands shall recite the Oath pledging to support the values of our University community when chancellor administers the pledge.
- When the graduation function is over, all shall remain standing in their places till the Procession leaves the hall.
