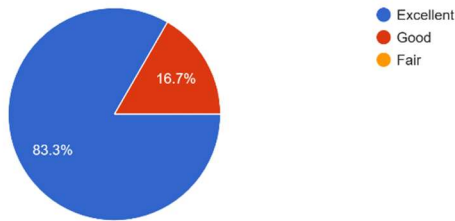

Feedback from participants

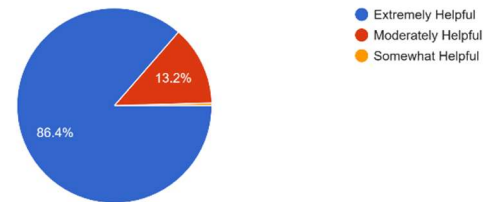
The total number of participants in the webinar in both sessions is 228 and their valuable feedback is presented below

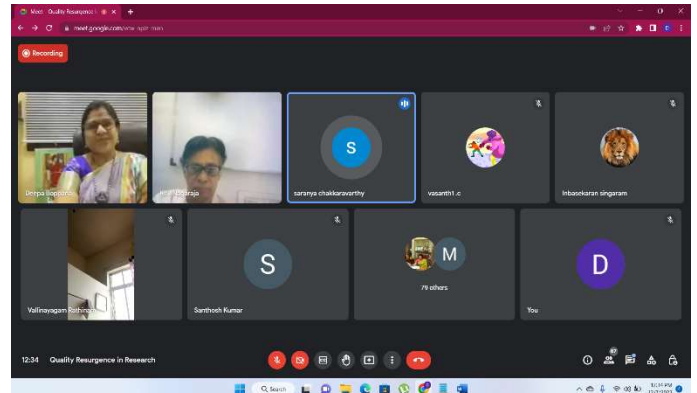
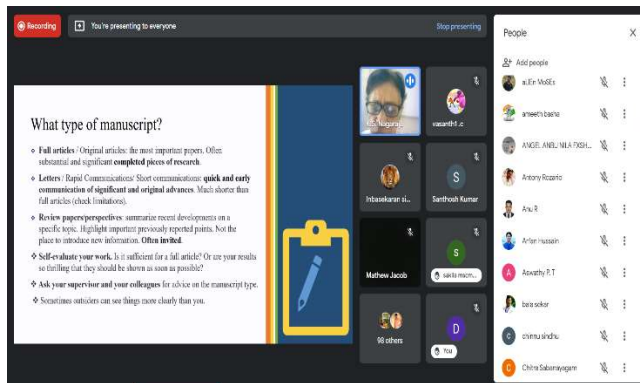
1.Presentation of the Resource Person:
