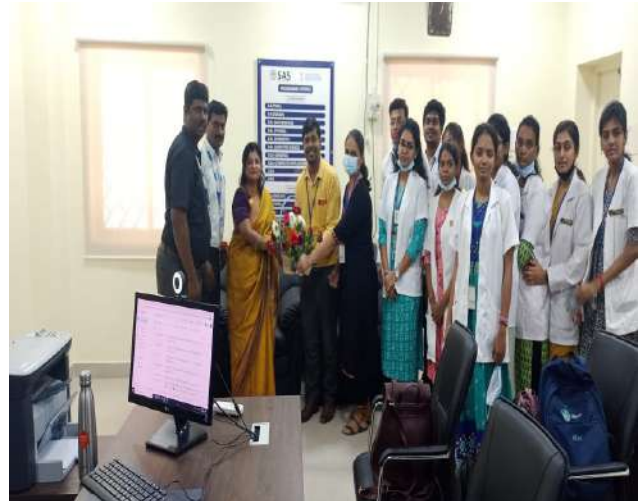
The department of public health dentistry granted us permission through Chettinad Dental College & Research Institute to conduct a dental awareness camp among the students to enlighten them with the knowledge of various aspects of dental hygiene and highlight the importance of the same on 21.09.2022 at School of Arts and Science, AV Campus Paiyanoor.

The meeting began with a welcome note from the **NSS & RRC Coordinators**, and the dental camp was presided by **Dr. Nazeema T H**, Director, SAS, AV Campus and the Director, SAS welcomed all the doctors and gave a flower bouquet, as a token of gratitude.

ELEMENTS OF OUR CAMP

- Oral hygiene instruction and brushing techniques explained to all the patients in the camp.
- After the demonstration, the patients were made to imitate the same.

- Oral screening was done to assess the oral hygiene, dental caries, periodontal problems, malocclusion, fractures and other dental anomalies.
- All queries regarding the brushing techniques and oral hygiene were explained individually to the patients in detail.



A dental screening setup was made at the college premises thereafter. The Dental Screening camp started by 10.00 a.m. in the auditorium of AV Campus with a group of doctors led by Dr. Nagaland. Registration slips were distributed to all classes through their Faculty Advisors. Registered candidates were

sent in for the screening process.

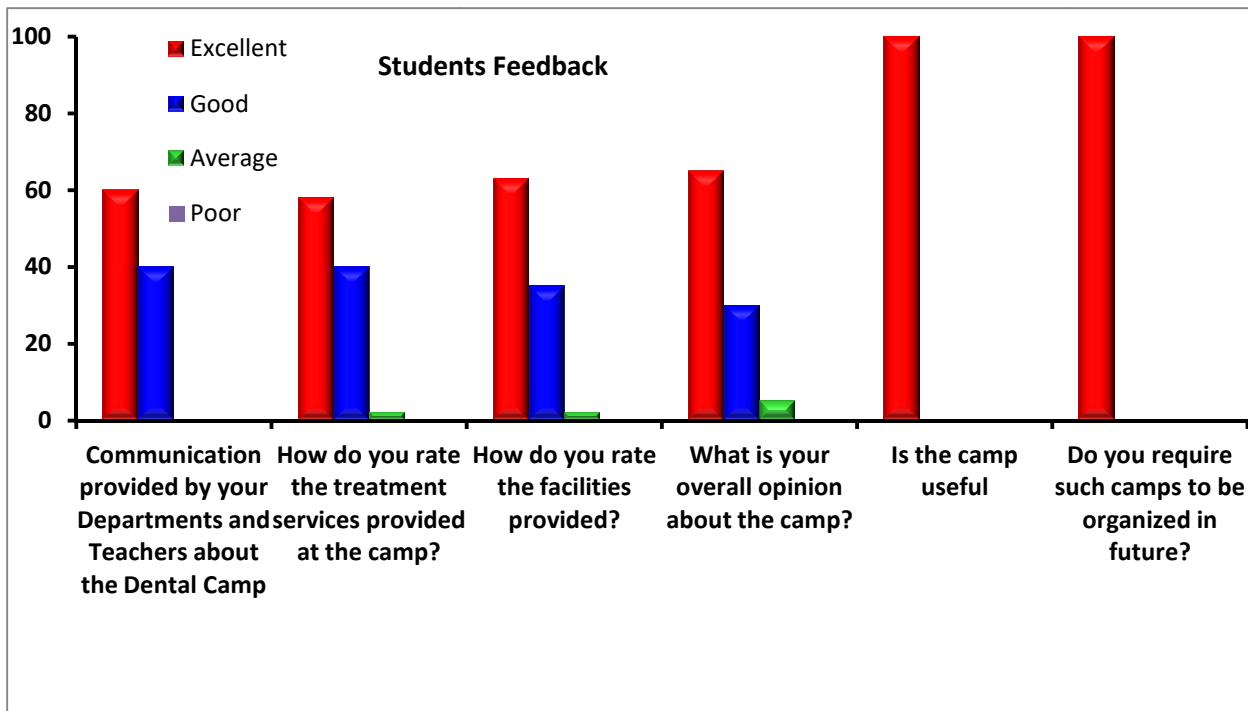
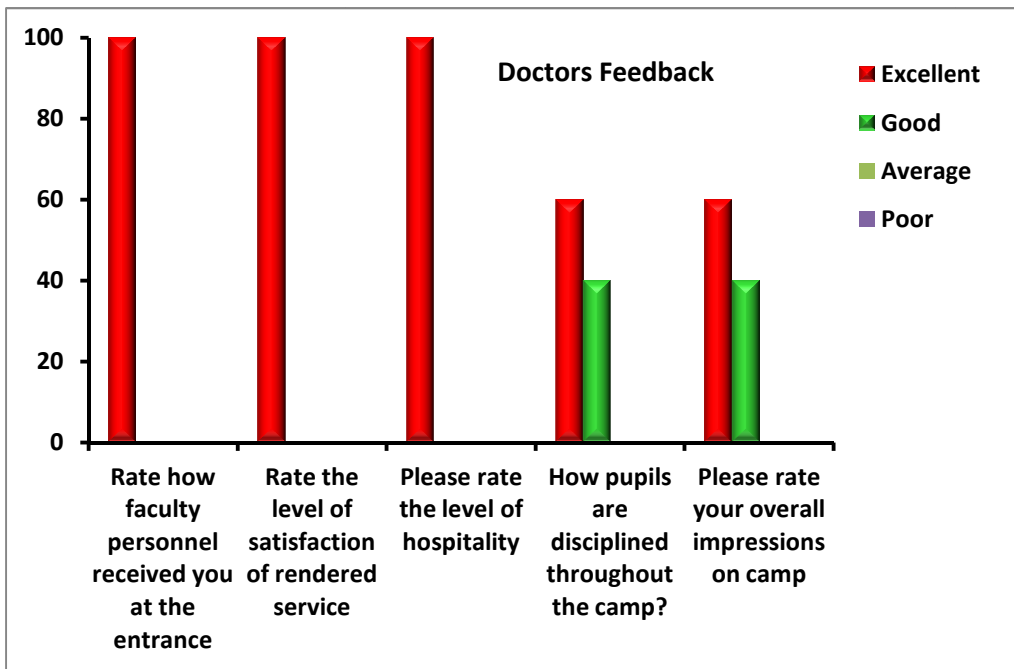
