The 32<sup>nd</sup> webinar of the quality webinar series titled "IQAC in the New Education Policy Era" was organised by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), School of Arts and Science (SAS), Paiyanoor. The webinar took place on September 16, 2023, using a virtual platform.

The programme formally began with the welcome address delivered by the **Prof. Dr. T.H Nazeema, Director, SAS**. In her

addresses explained about the National Education Policy stresses on the core values and principle that education must develop not only the cognitive skills, that is, – both ‘foundational skills’ of literacy and numeracy and ‘higher-order’ skills such as critical thinking and problem solving – but also, social and emotional skills - also referred to as ‘soft skills’ -including cultural awareness and empathy, perseverance and grit, teamwork, leadership, communication, among others.

Presidential address was given by **Director-IQAC, VMRF(DU)**, during his speech, director highlighted the crucial aspects of NEP 2020, such as inclusivity, equity, quality, affordability, and accountability, that promote learning opportunities for all. He emphasized the importance of a close connection with the industry, bridge courses, community engagement, experiential learning, and more, for the holistic development of learners.

As part of the quality efforts the technical session was led by the resource person **Prof. Dr. S. Ravi, Registrar, karpagam Academy of Higher education, Eechanri, Coimbatore, Tamilnadu, India.**

In his lecture he has elaborated about the importance of IQAC in new education policy era such as the IQAC's main responsibility is to initiate, plan, and supervise activities that increase the quality of education in an institution.

The IQAC's responsibilities include:

- Ensuring the timely, efficient, and progressive performance of academic, administrative, and financial tasks.
- Ensuring the relevance and quality of academic and research programs.

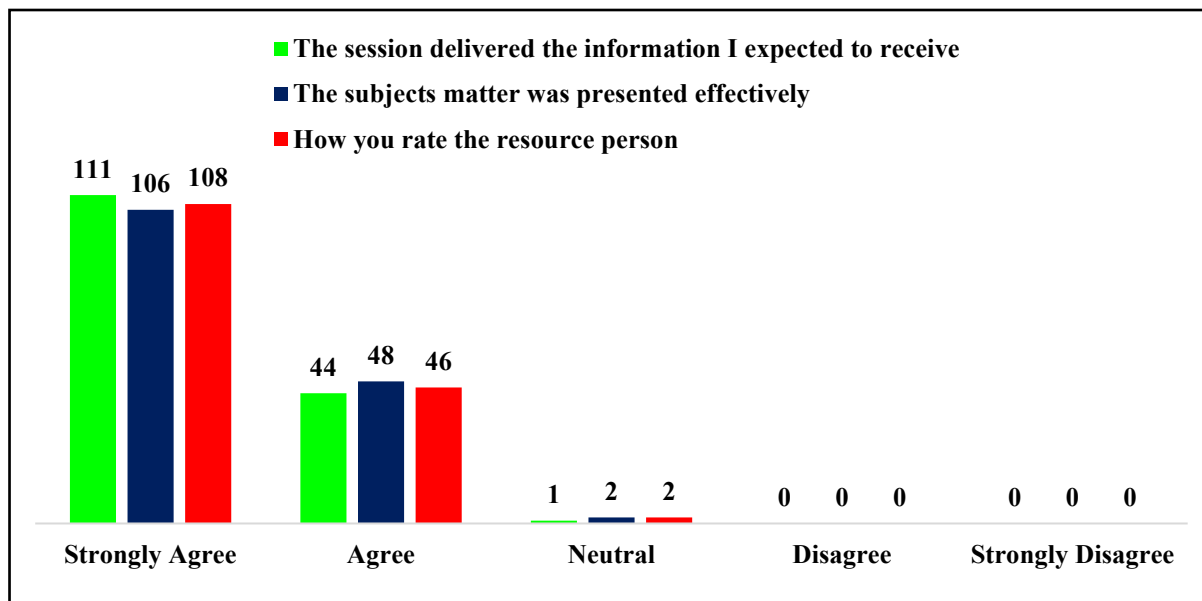

**PARTICIPANT’S DETAILS:**

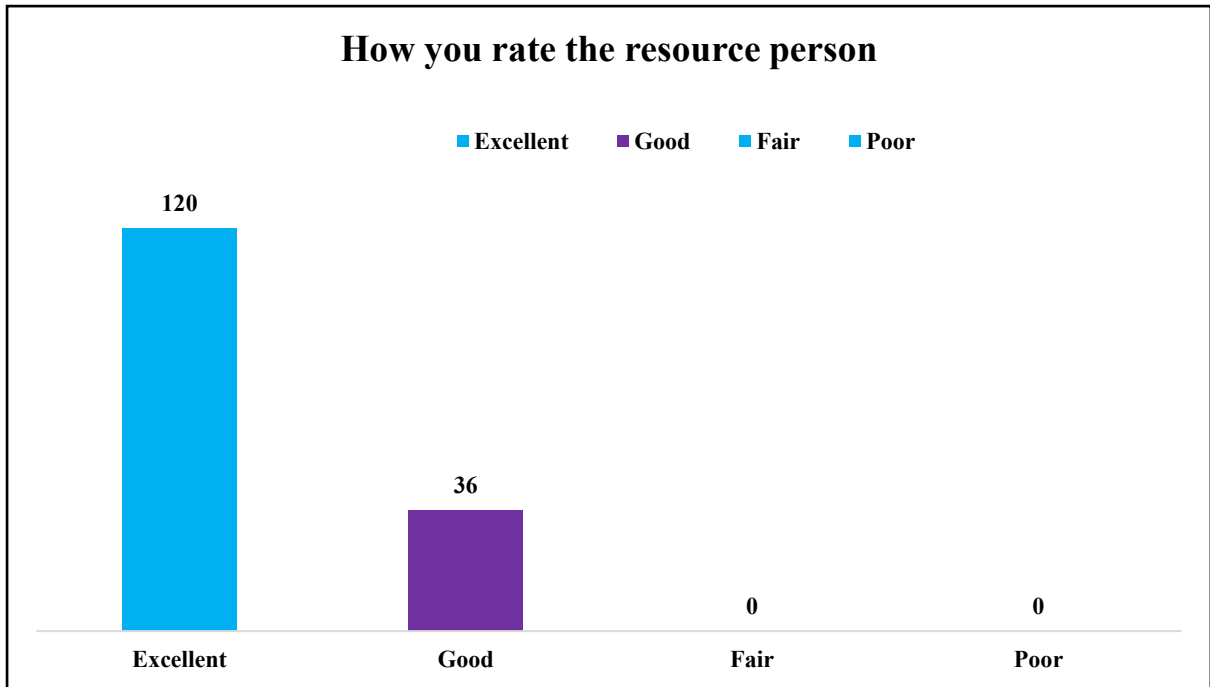
