REPORT ON RESEARCH METHODOLOGY WORKSHOP

School of Arts and Science (SAS) and the Department of Management (affiliated institutes of VMRF) conducted the five days (5 X 4 = 20 hrs.) research methodology workshop from 31-05-2021 to 04-06-2021 to motivate the research steps and ethics among the faculties.

31st May 2021: Introduction, defining a research problem, refining research questions, Formulating objectives and hypothesis, Research Designs -1. Selecting appropriate research designs, Observational designs, Cross- Sectional studies.

The workshop began with inaugural function on 31st May at 9.50 am and was carried on with the Thamizhthai Vazhthu. Ms. Padmaragam, Head of the Department of English welcomed the gathering, the chief guest Dr. S. A. V. Sathyamoorthy, Director Research, VMRF, Dean & Director Dr. R. Shanmugavalli, School of Arts and Science, VMRF (DU), Both the institute faculties Dean & Director of Management, VMRF (DU) P. S. Balaganapathy. & Dr. R. Shanmugavalli, School of Arts and Science, VMRF (DU) gave presidential address and explained the importance of research in the present scenario. 1st June 2021Research design-2: Case-Control studies in research, Cohort studies in research; Research Designs- 3-Experimental: Before- After studies of a research problem, Randomized controlled trial

Day three of the workshop was headed by Prof. P. S. Balaganapathy, explicated the research design and studies into two branches: Case-Control studies and Cohort studies. The nuances of the study focused on developing a research thesis and writing research articles in particular. The quality of research stood the main ingredients.
