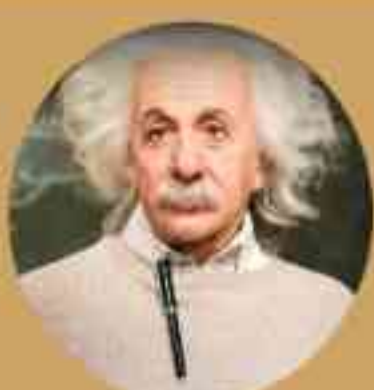
The Literary Week: A Celebration of Creativity and Literary Excellence
